  A\*—the highest accolades on the Australian Business Deans Council (ABDC) journal list,
  recognized globally as the gold standard for business publication rankings.

### Economics Ph.D.

- The Ph.D. program ranked in the highly prestigious U.S. News & World Report. The
  program's ranking is the highest for any graduate program at MTSU. The ranking puts
  our Ph.D. in Economics in the same category as the other major universities, such as
  UTK and Vanderbilt.
- Students have presented their research at several recent national and international conferences, including the Southern Economic Association meetings and the Public Choice Society Conference.
- Our Ph.D. students have received recognition and awards from other universities and organizations, such as the Adam Smith Fellowship, the American Enterprise Institute, and the CATO Institute. Additionally, they have published numerous articles during the last few years, including in journals well-ranked by the Australian Business Deans Council (ABDC).
